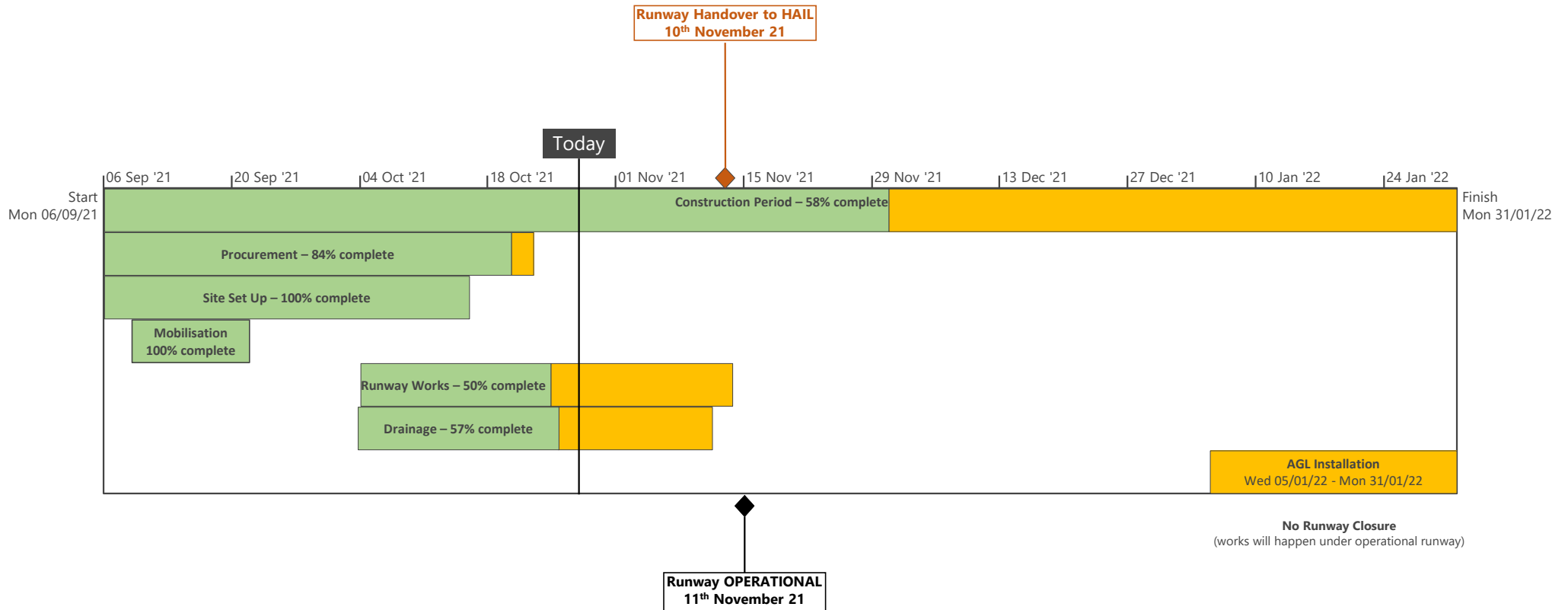

5. Runway operate with existing signage
6. Flight calibration on the 10th November 2021

1. Lagan has employed two local Campbeltown persons currently on site.
2. Lagan has engaged with Argyll College to present Civil and Runway works together with Site Visits.
